White Slip

- Swearing directed at another student
- Teasing (making fun of someone including via digital communication or verbal)
- Theft of student property (e.g. pencil, dice, food, money below \$2 consult with AP)
- Disruptive and non-compliant behaviour (moved through the class chart system)
- Deliberately throwing objects (e.g. consider the risk of harm)
- Inappropriate physical contact (e.g. pushing, tripping, pinching, scratching, hat flipping, rough play, tackling)
- Leaving the learning space without permission (e.g. allocated playground area, classroom, library)
- Off-task use of school devices (e.g. low level playing games instead of instructed research)
- Walking to back gate without a teacher or parent/caregiver

Consequence and support

- Name is moved on PBL Class Chart
- Does not receive PBL daily stamp
- Classroom teacher to contact parent/caregiver for 1st and 2nd white slips.
- Third White Slip within a term escalates to a Behaviour Card



Behaviour Card - Level 1

- Swearing directed at staff
- Harassment (e.g. personal, gender, race or religion digital or verbal)
- Repeated disruptive behavior and/or non-compliant behaviour (moved through PBL system)
- Vandalism (e.g. graffiti, damaging property on purpose)
- Physical aggression and intimidation (e.g. hitting, kicking, inappropriate touching, threatening or initiating violence, retaliation)
- Repeatedly leaving the learning space without permission (e.g. allocated playground area, classroom, library)
- Inappropriate device use (e.g. explicit searches, sharing of information, misuse of a school or personal device)

Student receiving a White Slip for targeted behaviour whilst on level card escalates to Behaviour Card level 2.

Consequence and support

- Managed by CRT in consultation with AP. CRT to contact parent/caregiver for all level 1 cards.
- 5 days on card, 2 days in timeout. Reviewed at the end of the week (may also move to 5 days on a monitoring card).
- Student does not receive any PBL Awards at assembly for the duration of the Behaviour Card.
- Excluded from incursions, excursions, PSSA, PBL Rewards session for the duration of the Behaviour Card.
- Exclusion from equipment if related to behaviour (sport, playground equipment or technology).
- Receiving a verbal warning or white slip on behavior card (unless for targeted behavior) will result in an additional day on a Level 1 behavior card.
- May result in referral to Anti-Bullying Officer or the ARCO
- At completion of Behaviour Card Level 1, student restarts and moves through PBL system.

Behaviour Card – Level 2

- Ongoing harassment (e.g. personal, gender, race or religion digital or verbal)
- Theft of major property (e.g.personal property, money greater than \$2, handbag, wallets/purse, devices)
- Ongoing disruptive and non-compliant behaviour (moved through PBL system)
- Targeted vandalism towards staff and students
- Throwing/upturning objects (e.g.furniture, bins, library equipment)
- Using violence (e.g. physical fighting, inciting violence and aggressive intimidation)
- Leaving school grounds, external learning space (e.g. excursion sites) or truancy
- Intentional misuse of a device (e.g. threatening, harassment, impersonating a student, photos/videos/audio without teacher permission, phone not stored in school office)
- Third White Slip after completing Level 1 Behaviour Card, in the same term.

Student receiving a White Slip for targeted behaviour whilst on level card escalate to Behaviour Card level 3.

Consequence and support

- Managed by AP in consultation with DP/P.
- AP to contact parent/caregiver for all level 2 cards and arrange meeting.
- 5 days on card, 3 days in timeout. Reviewed at the end of the week (may also move to 5 days on a monitoring card).
- Student does not receive any PBL awards at assembly for the duration of the Behaviour Card.
- Excluded from incursions, excursions, PSSA, PBL Rewards session for the duration of the Behaviour Card.
- Exclusion from equipment (sport, playground equipment or technology).
- Receiving a verbal warning or white slip on behavior card (unless for targeted behavior) will result in an additional day on a Level 2 behavior card.
- Possible warning of suspension.
- May result in a referral to Anti-Bullying Officer or the ARCO.
- At completion of a Behaviour Card Level 2, student restarts and moves through PBL system.
- Discuss at stage meeting. More than 2 Level 2 Behaviour Cards calendar year results in referral to Learning Support Team.

Behaviour Card – Level 3

- Ongoing abuse/harassment (e.g. threatening, intimidation, personal, gender, race or religion digital or verbal)
- Theft by force, threat or intimidation
- Targeted violence and physical aggression
- Accessing social media at school on personal or school devices
- Third White Slip after completing Level 2 Behaviour Card, in the same term.

Automatic Suspension

- Bringing weapons to school
- Bringing any illegal substance to school (e.g. cigarettes, e-cigarettes, alcohol, drugs)
- Misuse of device illegal behaviour and posting to social media (Breaking the Surveillance Devices Act of 2007)







Consequence and support

- Managed by DP/P.
- DP/P to contact parent/caregiver for level 3 cards and arrange meeting.
- Level 3 5 days on card, 5 days in timeout. Reviewed at the end of the week. Further 10 days on a monitoring card.
- Student does not receive any PBL awards at assembly for the duration of the Behaviour Card.
- Excluded from incursions, excursions, PSSA, PBL Rewards Session for the duration of the Behaviour Card.
- Exclusion from equipment (sport, playground equipment or technology).
- Receiving a verbal warning or white slip on behavior card will result in an additional day on a Level 3 behavior card.
- Warning of suspension.
- After a Behaviour Card Level 3, student restarts and moves through PBL system.
- Referral to Learning Support Team.

Consequence - Suspension

- Suspension 1 week on a monitoring card reviewed with the possibility of extension up to 3 weeks.
- In line with Department of Education Suspension and Expulsion Policy.
